Online Talk via Zoom

In the 23rd offering of our Experts Next Door online series, Kieran O'Keefe of Lyon University will explore the topic of Loyalists in the Hudson Valley during the Revolutionary War. He will examine why some colonists remained loyal to the Crown, what the war was like for Loyalists in the region, and what happened to Loyalists after the conflict.
