Stop by with the family to spend a few minutes walking through an important piece of Greenfield history: the one-room Daketown Schoolhouse, that dates back to late 1800s. It's located at Old Daketown Road in Middle Grove. Historians will be on-site and you can view some original relics inside. Daketown Schoolhouse was the last one-room schoolhouse to close when the schools consolidated in 1956.
