**BALLSTON SPA SCHOOLS.** Records 1915–2005.  
Includes annual reports, clippings, student publications, photographs, and a series of “Record of Vocational Work” (home economics) arranged by surname 1916–33. Also included are scattered issues of *The Buzzer*, high school magazine, 1931–40.

**BURNT HILLS ORATORIO SOCIETY.** Records 1970–2012. 3 boxes  
These appear to be complete files assembled at the time. The collection includes recordings.
